Conditions of Entry

All players submitting entries for this tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which this tournament is to be conducted.

Rules and Regulations

- i. The rules of play shall be in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and 2020 WCBF Pacific Cup – Conditions of Entry.
- ii. This event will be played using the Alternative Service Law 9.1.6., rather than the new “Fixed Height” service rule.
- iii. Following one warning of misconduct, the Referee may disqualify a player from further play if there is a repeat of misconduct of any sort.
- iv. Players must abide by all decisions of the Tournament Director and Referee, and comply with all the instructions given.
- v. Players may be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within 2 minutes after being called.
- vi. Player replacement are permissible only with the approval of the referee, before 9/04/2020. No replacement for singles event.
- vii. The Referee’s decision on all questions as to the Rules of Play and the Laws of Badminton are final.
- viii. Player ranking will be decided by the Referee, with information available at that point of time when ranking is done.
- ix. All entries must be true, correct and honest. Players may be disqualified if found otherwise and entry fees will be forfeited.

Player Responsibilities

- i. Players must wear regulation badminton clothing. Non-marking shoes must be worn by players.
- ii. Players are responsible for finding their own partner. If requested, we can try to find a partner for you but no guarantee or of same level playing skills.
- iii. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament and safety of players’ belongings.

Event Details

- i. The Tournament Director reserves the right to cancel any event in which insufficient entries are received or change the scoring points if time constraints dictate.
- ii. Player can register for 1 or 2 events but **only 1 event from either Doubles Open or Age Groups Doubles.**

Doubles Open Event

Women Doubles & Men Doubles

- i. No grading and minimum age is 13 years old.
- ii. If there are not enough entries, the Tournament Director may combined the Women Doubles & Men Doubles together into 1 event and the players will be informed of this and have the option to withdraw from the event with full refund.

Age Groups Doubles Event

Women Doubles, Men Doubles & Mixed Doubles

- i. No grading and minimum age is 13 years old.
- ii. Women Doubles, Men Doubles & Mixed Doubles compete together in the same Age Group.
- iii. You must attach a copy of any ID that shows proof of age to be eligible to play in entered age group. If you had played Age Group Doubles in 2019, you do not have to email proof of ID unless requested. Failure to do so, the Tournament Director and the Referee have the right and may decline your entry.

Age Criteria

Age Group 45+ & 60+

- i. The younger age of the 2 players determined the eligible age group.

Age Group 13S+, 13+ & 30+

- i. Both players must be within the age range specified.

Examples in entering the correct Age Group

Age: 1st player 48 yrs old [45+ age group], 2nd player 35 yrs old [30+ age group]
Age group: 30+ age group

Age: 1st player 28 yrs old [19+ age group], 2nd player 35 yrs old [30+ age group]
Age group: Cannot play unless 1 player is replaced

Age Group 13S+

- i. For social players only.
- ii. NZ Junior representative players, Badminton Association Junior representative players and players that participated in NZ Junior Team Championships and NZ Division 1 & 2 in 2018, 2019 & 2020 are not eligible.

This social age group category is specifically created to encourage social players and beginner players to participate in tournament against players within their same level of skills, without the feeling of pressure playing against experience and higher skill players.

Singles Open Event

Women Singles & Men Singles

- i. No grading and minimum age is 13 years old.
- ii. If there are not enough entries, the Tournament Director may combined the Women Singles & Men Singles together into 1 event and the players will be informed of this and have the option to withdraw from the event with full refund.
- iii. Depending on number of entries, the draw may be Round Robin or Elimination.

Score Format

- i. Singles Open, Doubles Open & Age Group Open play best of 3 games, 1 – 21 points with no extension.
- ii. For play off positions, semi-finals & final play best of 3 games, 1 – 21 points with extension.
- iii. Age group 13S+ plays 1 game, 1 – 31 points with extension.

Rest Time

Due to restricted court times for the day, rest time between matches are kept to minimum.

Entries

- i. Entry is limited to 200 +/-, to be decided by the Tournament Director.
- ii. WCBF Pacific Committee is not responsible for following up entries from nominated, un-entered partners or player that has entered but has not paid.
- iii. Mobile text or hand-written entry will not be accepted.

Payment

- i. \$40 for 1 event and \$50 for 2 events per player
- ii. Entry fee includes complementary lunch & tournament T-shirt.

- v. This tournament is organised and run by volunteers and their duties finish when the tournament is finished.
Their position ceases to exist. No player or their representative can bring a case against them or the tournament sponsors in any jurisdiction for whatever reasons and seek any form of compensation. Their liabilities are expressly excluded.
